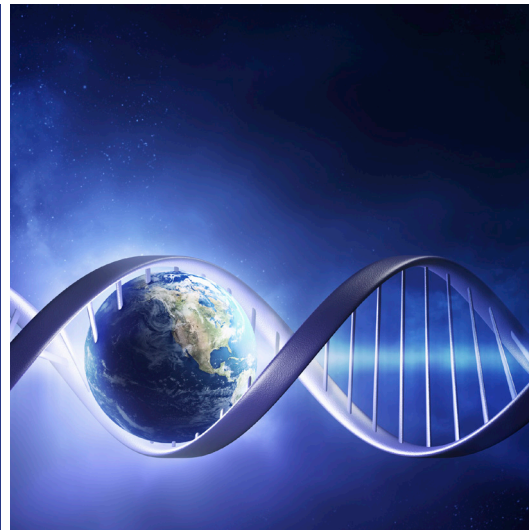

It has been published in some of the world's most influential journals in medicine, cardiology, social science, nursing, and rehabilitation. He works locally, nationally and internationally as a mentor – contributions for which the World Economic Forum accorded him the status of: 'Young Global Leader' in 2011. For four years, he was Co-Chair of the largest qualitative health research conference in the world.
